He was born July 28, 1960 in Austin, TX to Robert Edward Kennedy, Jr. and Norma (Dolley) Kennedy. He attended Fayetteville Public Schools through junior high and attended Kemper Military Academy where he lettered in golf and basketball. He graduated in 1978 and moved to Austin, TX to attend Austin Community College then transferred to the University of Arkansas to complete a Bachelor's Degree in Finance.
