Eugene Tolbert Huckabay, 73, of Conway, Arkansas, passed away Saturday, July 19, 2008, in Little Rock. He was born July 5, 1935 in St. Louis, Missouri. The son of Eugene Franklin Huckabay and Margaret (Herbert) Clark. He was a graduate of Harrison High School after which he enlisted in the United States Army National Guard in 1952. He was in active duty in 1957. Eugene then went on and served with the 4154 U.S. Army Reserve Forces School in North Little Rock and was awarded the meritorious service medal in recognition of 42 years of military service at Camp Pike and retired a Chief Warrant Officer (CW4) in 1995, with the 4154th as a civilian employee of the Department of Defense.
