William Randall Doyle, 52, of Elkins, Arkansas passed away Tuesday July 10, 2007 in Fayetteville. The son of Heral Ray and Mary Louise Spicer Doyle, he was a veteran of the United States Marine Corps, where he served in Vietnam. He was also a retired doctor of Naturopathic Medicines, and a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.
