Anthony A. Palumbo, Sr., age 88, of New Orleans, Louisiana died Tuesday, August 19, 2003 in Springdale, Arkansas. He was born November 16, 1914 in Rochester, New York the son of Savario and Lucia Diamato Palumbo. He was a retired Lieutenant Colonel in the U.S. Army and was awarded the Purple Heart and a Silver Star for gallantry in action during WWII.

Survivors include three sons, Samuel R. Palumbo of Meridian, Idaho, Anthony A. Palumbo, Jr. of Columbus, Ohio, Albert A.
