Isaac F. Caudle, age 94, of West Fork died Wednesday, May 15, 2019. He was born January 19, 1925 in Winslow, Arkansas, the son of Samuel Isaac and Allie Goff Caudle. 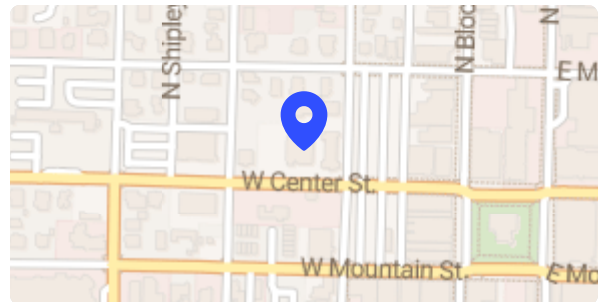

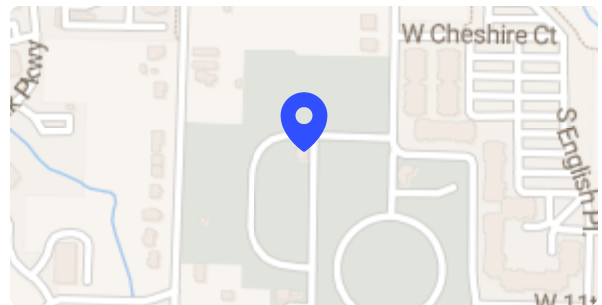
