Rebecca "Becky" Jean Hashbarger, age 63, passed away on Friday, November 29, 2019, at Northwest Medical Center in Springdale. She was born on December 1, 1955, in Wichita, Kansas, to John and Billie Jean (Barnett) Hudson. She is preceded in death by her mother.

Becky graduated from Hominy High School in 1973. She went on to obtain her Bachelor of Science in nursing from Oral Roberts University graduating in 1977. She married the love of her life, Jim Harshbarger, on April 21, 1979. Becky spent her life helping others and that is why she pursued a degree in nursing where she began in pediatrics and then spent the remainder of her career as a school nurse and a member of the National Association of School Nurses. She belonged to the P.E.O. International which is a philanthropic organization that is "Women helping women reach for the stars." She loved to shop and was always thinking about what her family and those around her might need.

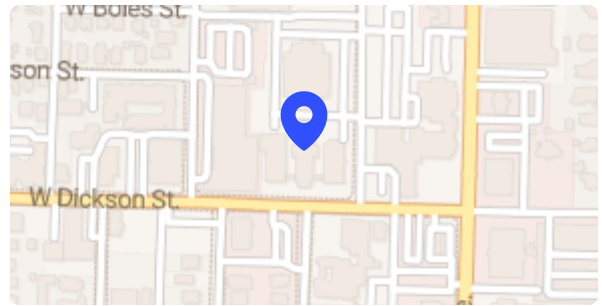

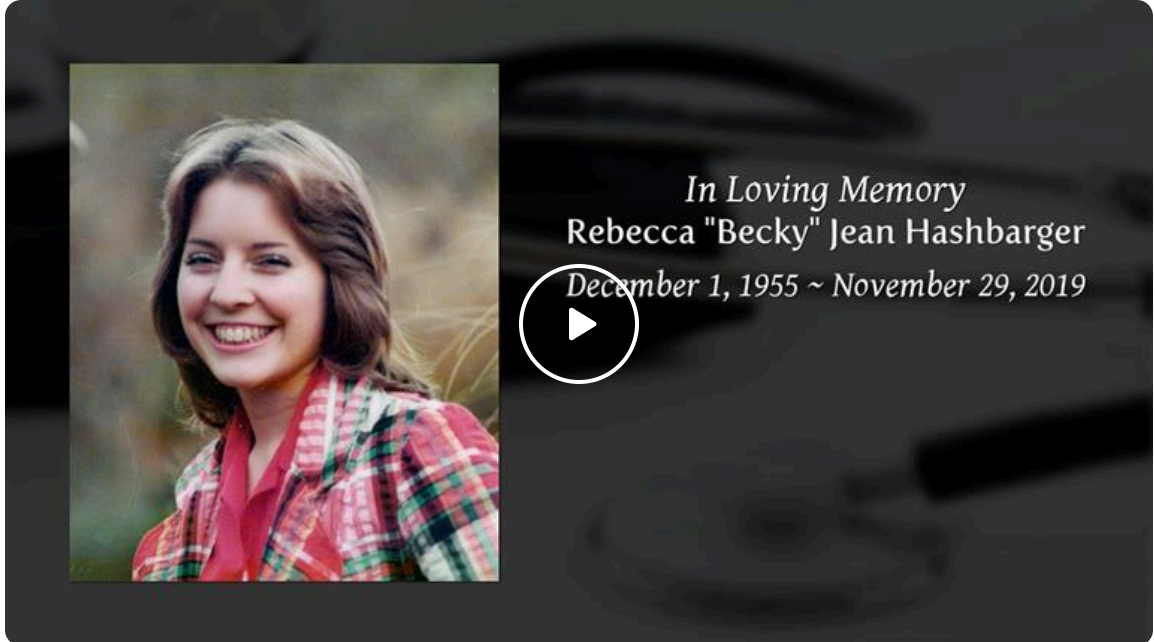
