Jean loved to work with all kinds of arts and crafts and flower arrangements. She retired from Walmart after 16 years of service. She was an active member of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church in Rogers where she was instrumental in promoting the church's perpetual adoration program. She was among the first to help establish the parish food pantry, and served as a homebound minister. Jean was also a regional director in the Third Order of the Lay Carmelites, as well as an active member of the American Legion.

Memorials can be sent to the St Vincent de Paul Food Pantry.



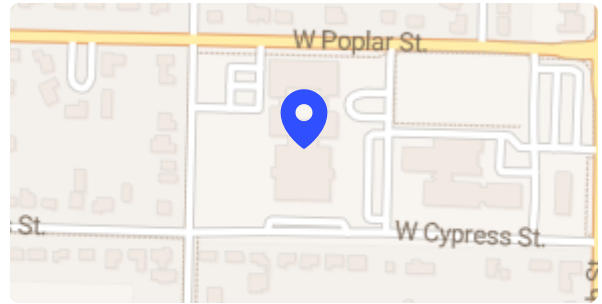

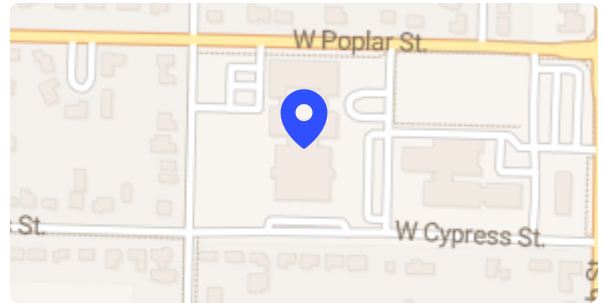

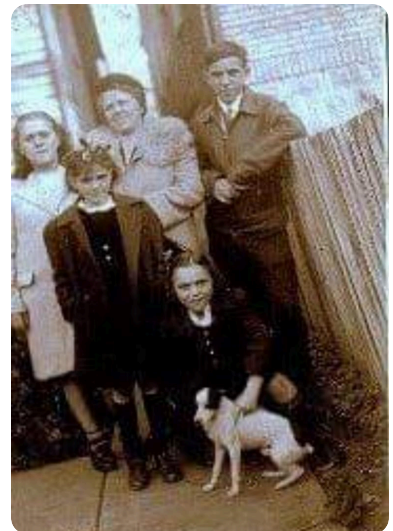
