Jane Marie Reynolds, age 74, of Fayetteville, died Thursday, April 29, 2021 in Fayetteville. She was born December 14, 1946 in Shamokin, Pennsylvania, the daughter of Robert and Emily Wendell Martz.

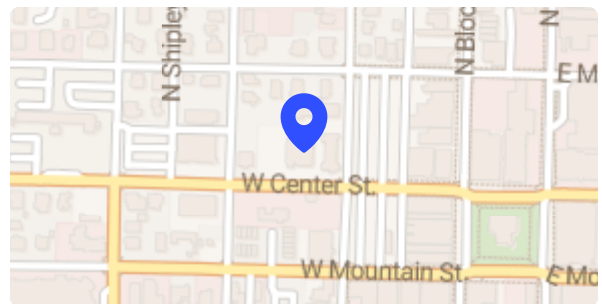
