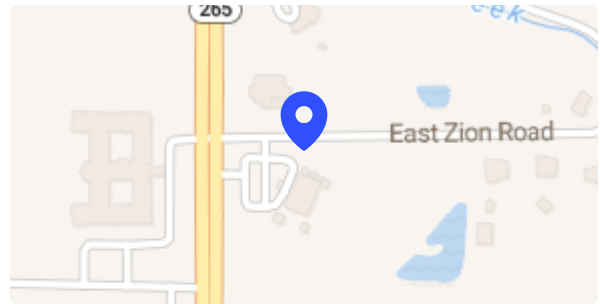
She is survived by nieces; a nephew; and extended family members.

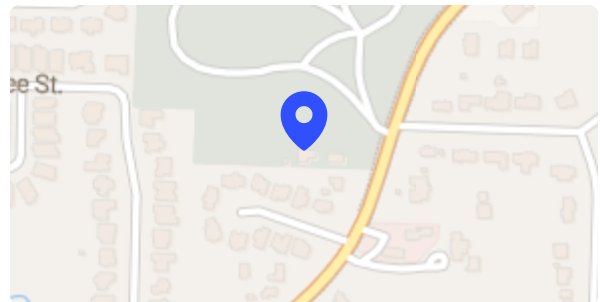

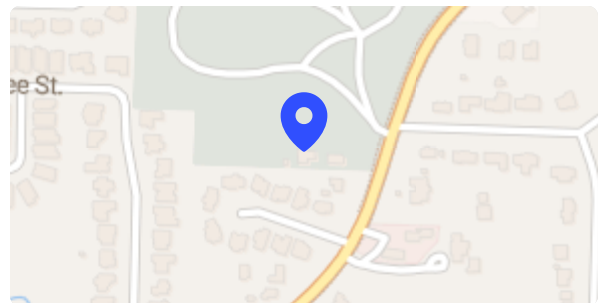
