## **Linda Lee Cassell**

DEC 8, 1948 - JAN 24, 2022

She was born on December 8, 1948, in Gilmer, Texas, to Everett and Clarine (Tittle) Weldon. Linda graduated from Denison High School in 1967. She married her high school sweetheart Jerry Cassell on January 27, 1968. Linda attended East Texas State University where she graduated with a master's degree in Education. She was a beloved teacher for 48 years working in elementary schools as well as teaching middle school and high school math. She absolutely loved anything sports related, traveling with Jerry, and spending time with her children and grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents.

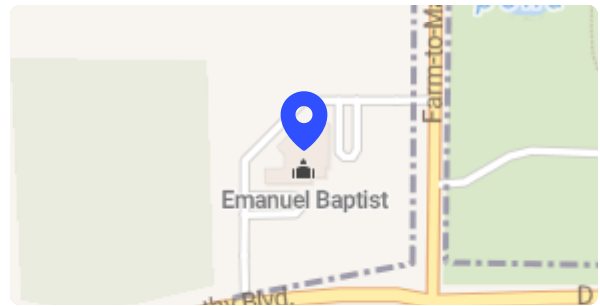

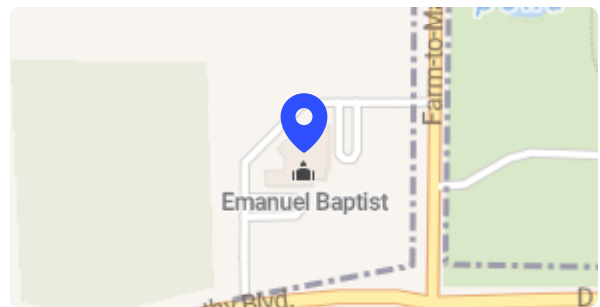
