Greg A. Head, 54 of Springdale, AR passed away on Thursday, December 22, 2022 in Springdale. He was born November 9, 1968 in Eureka Springs, AR to Joe and Kathryn (Clark) Head.

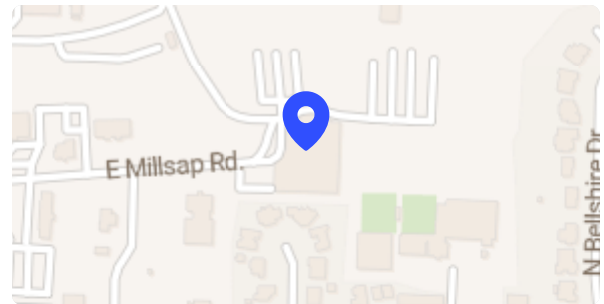

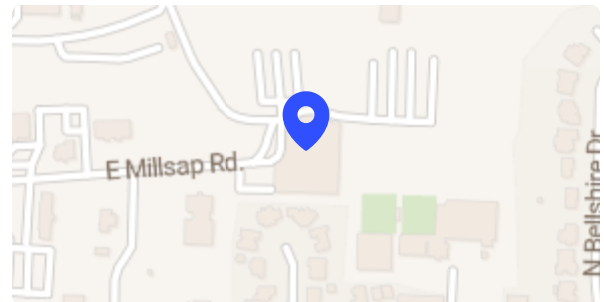
