Neala VanBaale, 66, of Cave Springs, AR formerly of Sedalia, MO died Saturday March 11, 2023, at her home surrounded by family.

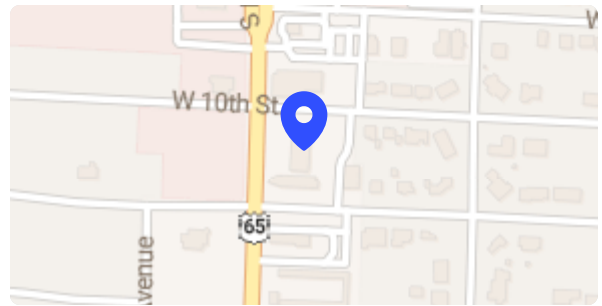
