In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be made to First United Methodist Church food pantry, Second Street Pantry Mission or the First United Methodist memorial fund.



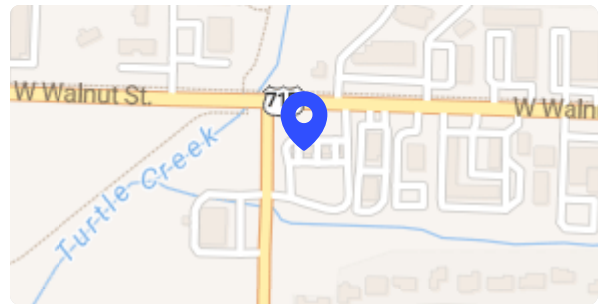

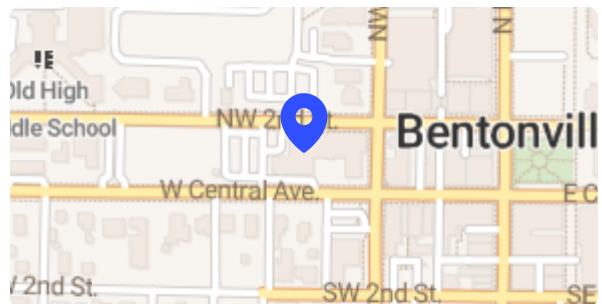

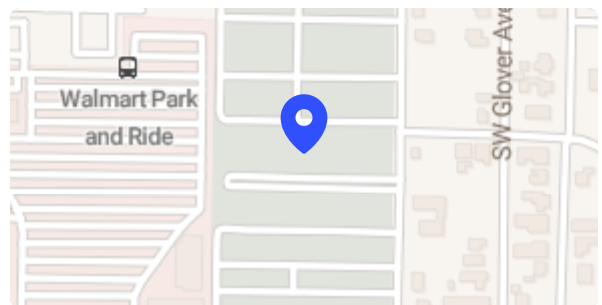
