Ann Warren Powers, of Rogers, passed away on Tuesday, September 19, 2023. She was born on August 20, 1940, in Jacksonville, Florida to Bankhead and Joy Waist Warren. Ann had a sister, Roberta Joy Abstein, who preceded her in death.

Ann was a remarkable individual whose life was characterized by her unwavering dedication to her passions. 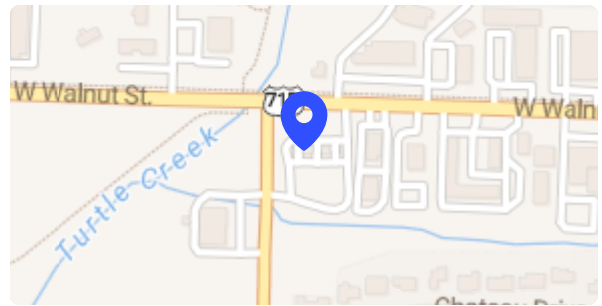
