You could always catch him researching gun parts as well as specific guns that he wanted to add to his collection. Dale was a sponsor of the Benton County Quail Unlimited Nonprofit organization. During their earlier years of marriage, they went on many amazing scuba diving adventures. He went to real estate school from 1988 to 1989 and was a licensed realtor for a brief time from 1989 to 1992. During this time, they purchased their current house which he completely rebuilt with the help of his father-in-law Vernon Hayworth. From 1990 he raised show cattle, then in 1997 he also had his own business of building and selling hitch covers which ran for 10 years with his wife Patti. After the cattle business ended in 2008, they bought an old farm and tore down the farmhouse, spent countless hours cleaning up the property, then created a subdivision which is known as the farms." He did all of this while working his day job at Preformed Line Products which he finally retired from in January of 2023 after a 40-year career with them, ending as the maintenance supervisor. 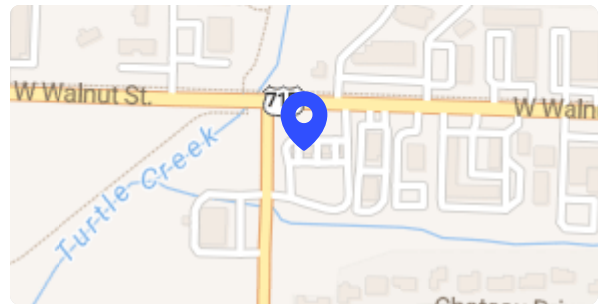

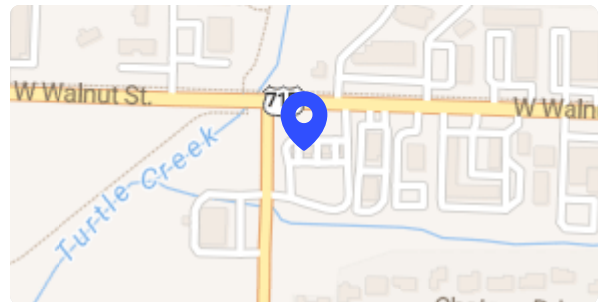

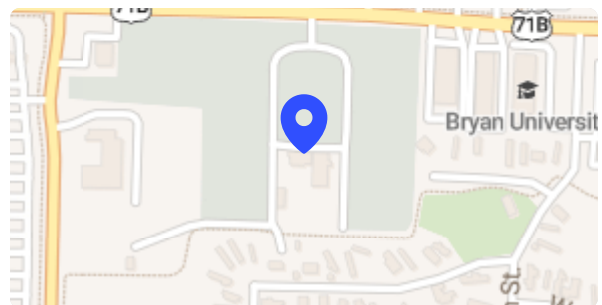
