Sherry Ann Martin Lindsay passed to eternal life with her Savior, surrounded by family on July 30, 2025 at Willard Walker Hospice Home in Fayetteville, AR.

Sherry was born to Merle and Lois Martin in Pine Bluff, Arkansas on April 9th, 1953. She married her high school sweetheart, Mark Lindsay, on December 30th, 1972 and they made their home in Fayetteville. After graduating from the University of Arkansas in 1975 she taught at Jones Elementary for seven years before taking time off to raise her three children at home. 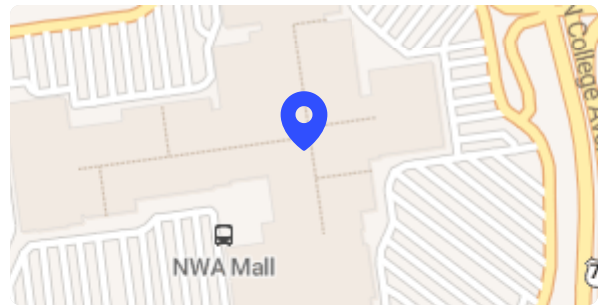

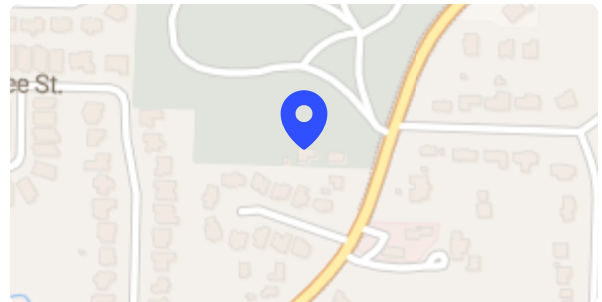

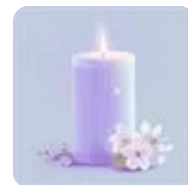
