Hugh Leslie Hyde, 82 of Fayetteville, AR passed Monday, August 18, 2025 in Fayetteville. He was born April 9, 1943 in Paragould, AR to Eric Grant Hyde and Vaudean (Rogers) Hyde.

He graduated from Arkansas State University in 1963 with a degree in accounting and began a 29 year career with KPMG. After retirement he became a bank president for 2 years then began a 10 year career in investment banking.

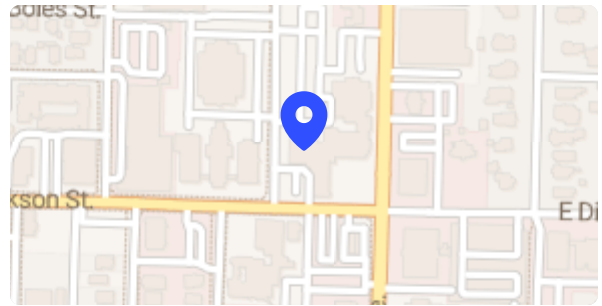
