Anita Cheryl (Tomlinson) Sweigart, born December 6, 1958, in Fayetteville, Arkansas, passed away on her birthday, December 6, 2025, at Washington Regional Medical Center. She was the daughter of Omar Tomlinson and Josephene (Meadors) and grew up in Winslow, where she graduated from Winslow High School in 1977. She was a cheerleader, a dedicated student, and someone who made friends everywhere she went.

Anita married Carl Sweigart in 1978, and life only got fuller from there—two daughters, plenty of laughter, and eventually the grandchildren who completely stole their hearts.

Anita is survived by her husband, Carl; her daughters Ashley Taylor (husband David) of Prairie Grove and their children Brooks (10), Campbell (6), and Ford (4); and Hayley Long (husband Wesley) of Prairie Grove and their children Millie (6) and Benton (4). 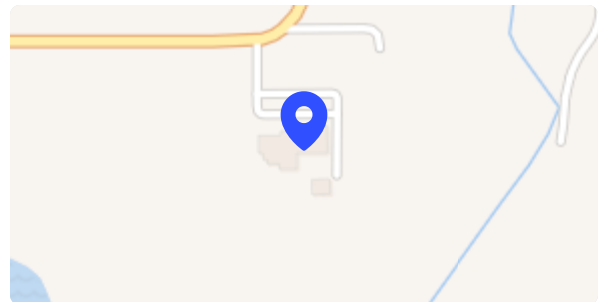

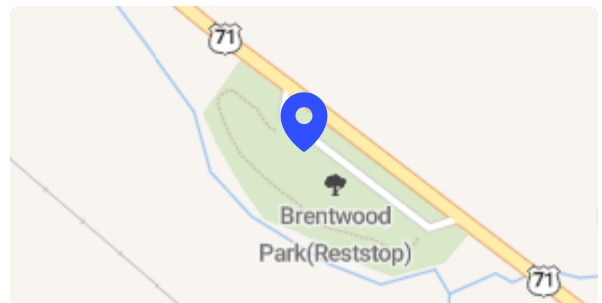
