John Winford Harris passed away on Sunday December 21st at Peachtree Village in Farmington, Arkansas. He was born July 20, 1950 in Marked Tree, Arkansas to Carl and Ann [Winford] Harris of Marianna, Arkansas. He was a navy veteran who served on the USS Forrestal from 1971-1974 as an aviation electrician. He worked for the University of Arkansas' department of Computing Services and was a deputy for the Washington County Sheriff's Department. He was also mayor of Farmington, Arkansas from 2003- 2006. He loved sailing, woodworking and fishing and attended Central United Methodist Church in Fayetteville.
