Per Chase's request, a celebration of life will take place at the Elks Lodge in Fayetteville immediately following the burial service.



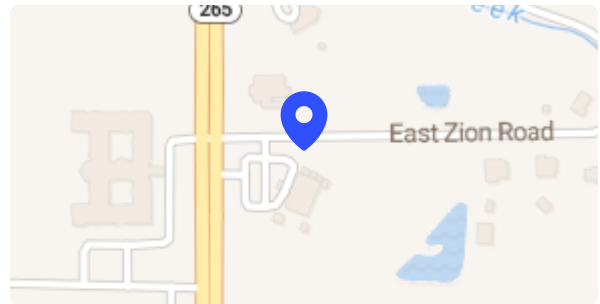
