**R**aymond Gregory "Greg" Miller, of Fayetteville, Arkansas, passed away on April 15, 2026, at the age of 83. He was born on June 9, 1942, in Buffalo, New York, to Hazel Dorthea Mulligan Miller and Raymond Gordon Miller.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his younger brother, Wendell Frank Miller of Lincolnton, North Carolina; and his stepmother, Mary Margaret Miller of Buffalo, New York.

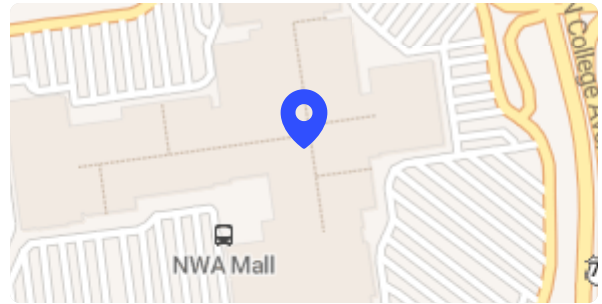
