Benjamin Wheatley Burton, 45, formerly of Benton and Fayetteville, AR, died March 15 in his adopted hometown of Minneapolis, MN.

Ben was the beloved son of Roger and Pam Burton of Fayetteville, who both survive him. Other survivors include his three sisters and their families: Sidney Burrow (Mike) of Hot Springs, and Lindsay Schupbach (Marcelo) and Erin Burton (Alfredo Lock) of Fayetteville.
